eCommunity is partnering with municipalities, economic development agencies, and community development corporations to leverage our network to enable enhanced sharing and exchange of community information and resources without using the Internet.

Before the wide use of the Internet, citizens relied upon word of mouth and the printed documents to disseminate information to each other. Once digitization of public information became the norm, those who did not have broadband access found themselves disconnected from each other and the broader community. This has led to a certain level of social decay fueled by technological isolation.

To overcome this barrier, we are enabling our partners to leverage eCommunity to establish an always' on Intranet that allows anyone who can't afford Internet to get direct access to the critical public information they need as well as engage directly with their elected officials, utility resources, and much more.
